Captions for photographs are not required but are highly recommended. They may be submitted by e-mail format and must be referenced to the appropriate photographs file name. Include photographs, logos, or other graphics if available.
- Photographs without articles **will** be considered for publishing in the newsletter and on the website. Photographs must have captions and or description of the photographed event.

- Include author's full name, and email address. No copyright protected material will be accepted without written approval from the author.
